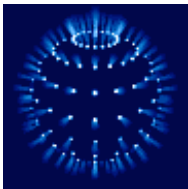

And maybe even post your "theory to date" in it's entirety in layman's terms so we are on the same page as you. You never know one of us might surprise you and further your investigation considerably.

Sticking up for me would be a distraction from the task at hand, and also a waste of time. As for a little respect, you have it. We are all relatively stale here. And I can stand that assessment. I hope that you can as well.

In my mind the enigma is a complex idea masked behind a relatively simple solution, and part of that complex idea involves the formation of intimate bonds between not just the enigmatists, but as many lifeforms as we can conglomerate into a specific idea and direction. Part of forming this "conglomeration" is the ability to "depend" on one another and have absolute trust in those we are working with. This is the only way we can operate as a **whole** functioning system and achieve goals that are otherwise beyond the realm of possibilities for a single individual. And that is why it is important to support one another rather than tear them down. We must encourage each other to "keep our eye on the ball" and offer positive conditioning rather than blatant negative reinforcements.

Now Im not asking you or anyone else here to blow smoke up anyones ass, and I definitely understand the need for constructive criticism and balance. But maybe we need to be a little more artistic with the way we word things rather than coming out and totally insulting someone to the point that they begin to doubt themselves and the time and effort they have spent on this subject.

I think its hard enough to find the time and energy to keep going on with this, let alone having someone tell you all you have acheived is garbage.

So you may think that it is a waste of time to discuss this here, but I beleive learning how to function in a team and in society in general is an essential tool and at the center of what were looking for.

Then again Im probably wrong as usual...

Sooner or later we have to "Shoehorn ideas" into specific categories. If we dot narrow down the possibilities then we will never get anywhere. The key to this approach is the ability to let go of ones ideas when they are proven to be wrong. Have you or anybody given Malcom any reasons why his research might be headed in the wrong direction or have you and others simply disregarded his work as "biblethumping" and "totally beyond the realm of reason" with no evidence backing up your claim? I too am skeptical of genesis but he has offered Malcom positive reinforcement for his ideas. If you were in malcom's shoes and it was you who was mentioned in the Genesis posts wouldn' t you continue on the same path, if nothing else to at least see what comes of it???

I do agree with your assessment that things around here are a bit stale, but thats because the enigma is becoming stale. To some of us such as Cordelia, it is becoming very exciting because his theories are making sense, and even my theories are being narrowed down and I must admit I too feel a certain level of exhilaration from day to day because of my personal findings and the New Publius reaction to some of my posts.

The new Publius has authenticated RacEcaR to me, and I beleive he authenticated Genesis to me in his most recent post where he left the clue "Revelations" but though he made an effort to authenticate himself it was fundamentally flawed and could have been orchestrated by anyone anywhere in the world. This differs imensily from the original Publii authentication because those signals at the concerts and in the music and in the artwork could only have been pulled off by someone close to or associated with the band. And until I have that type of evidence again from the New Publius I will remain skeptical of him and all those he has recognized. Its not fare to ask us as fans to just trust anybody who posts on the internet as Publius. Especially with the caliber of requests he is asking from us. I will not drop my entire life and family at the drop of a hat to leave on some quest around the world at the whim of someone claiming to be Publius. Its gonna take the same level of proof that the enigmatists ten years ago received, and I know its no easy task but its not our fault that the server had legal troubles and we lost contact with the original Publii. Shit happens, and now the process of authentication must begin all over again if Publius truly wants this enigma solved. Thats the problem with anonymous servers and if Publius is such a genius he/she/they should have thought about that problem and way to remedy it. This is not too much to ask, especially since they are asking so much of us and our time.

Now this doesnt mean Iam dismissing Genesis, RacEcaR, or New Publius because every avenue must be explored and I must pose the question to you Alan,
